Major George Walls deceased, of Harlan County and State of  
Kentucky have constituted made and appointed our trusty and  
loving Brother George Walls of Bourbon County and State  
aforesaid our true and lawfull attorney for us and in our names  
to sell and transfer by special Warranted deed or other wise (so that  
we are in no wise liable hereafter) all lands within the said state  
of Kentucky (Except 400 Acres lying in Woodford County which is  
in the Name of Thomas Walls) which we may own by her ships  
or avins, through our late father George Walls and our  
late Brother Thomas Walls, for the best price he can get for  
so that It is not less than four thousand dollars but should  
our said attorney <sup>not</sup> be able to sell said lands for the above  
mentioned sum we do further impower and authorize him  
to pursue said land Claims ~~with~~ he shall carry them into  
grant and investigate the titles so that the disputes are all settled in &  
to said lands - at his the said George Walls <sup>own</sup> proper costs  
and expence, for which trouble and expence we do agree &  
oblige ourselves to give to our said Attorney two fifths of <sup>the</sup> said  
land as he may be able to secure, But should our said  
attorney not think proper to pursue or investigate said titles  
We do then and in that case impower and authorize him  
to appoint or employ one or more attorneys or persons under  
him

him to transact the said business and to give them any  
share of said land he may think proper not exceeding two fifths  
and such power or authority so given to revoke or disannul  
at pleasure hereby empowering and authorizing our said attorney  
to do and to act in our names and stead in as fully amply  
and largely a manner as if we were personally present and  
have done the same our selves hereby ratifying confirming  
and holding for good whatsoever our said attorney shall by  
these presents lawfully do - In Testimony whereof we  
have here unto set our hands and affixed our seals  
this twentieth day of January in the year of our Lord  
one thousand eight hundred and eight
