The Hardin County Clerk's office will close to the public beginning Tuesday, March 17 at 4:30 p.m., and will remain closed until further notice. Core staff will continue to support phone calls, mail, online transactions, and to prepare and conduct the Primary election scheduled for June 23rd.

Automobile Registration and Titling

The public has three options for renewal of their vehicle registration. First, online renewal is available for most vehicles at drive.ky.gov. Second, registration renewals may be renewed by credit/debit card over the phone by calling 270-765-2171 option 2 for vehicle. Third, registration renewals may be mailed to:

Individuals that have purchased a vehicle or is transferring to another in state resident will need to retain their documents until we can reopen.

Recordings of Deeds, Mortgage and etc. can now be e-filed. Please use Simplifile, ePn, and CSC to e-record your documents.
