with him the said Benjamin to dwell and to serve from this day of the date of these presents until the said apprentice shall accomplish his full age of twenty one years according to the law in that case made and provided during all ~~such~~ ^{which} term the said apprentice his said master faithfully shall serve in all lawfull business according to his power wit and ability honestly orderly and obediently in all things demean and behave himself to his said Master during said term and the said Benjamin Helm doth for himself covenant and agree to and with the said Alexander Catlett that he the said Benjamin Helm the said apprentice in the art and mastery of the Clerks business which he now followeth shall and will teach and instruct or cause to be taught and instructed in the best way and manner that he can and shall and will during all the ~~term~~ term aforesaid find provide and allow unto the said apprentice sufficient meat drink and apparel, lodging, washing and all things necessary and fit for an apprentice and at the end thereof will pay unto the said apprentice ten dollars and double apparel of all kinds one suit to be decent and new In Witness whereof the parties to these presents hath hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first within written
