Richard Lee as Guardian of the said infant or-  
phans of Thos Redman dec'd free and clear from all  
demands suits damages costs or charges whatever  
of damages John Dye infant orphan of Anna Red  
man deceased which he the said John Dye has or  
may have against the said Richard Lee for the  
estate or my part of the estate which he the said D  
Richd has received or may here after receive and  
belonging to the said John Dye as heir of Anna Red-  
man deceased —

and the said Richard Lee doth for himself  
part. oblige himself to keep the said William Red-  
man as administrator of the said Thomas Redman de-  
ceased free and clear from all the infant orphans  
of the said Thomas Redman deceased that they  
shall not call on the said William Redman for  
any part of their Father's estate which the said  
William administered on. and the said Richard  
Lee further agree to and with the said William  
that he will forever keep him free and clear  
from all actions suits damages costs and charges  
whatever which the said William Redman as  
guardian administrator of the Thomas Redman deceased.  
and the said Richard Lee doth hereby (as Guar-  
dian of the said orphans) acknowledge  
that ~~William~~ Redman hath delivered  
unto the said Richard the said estate of  
Thos Redman all except the within men-  
tioned Judgment and some accounts which  
he is to deliver

Richard Lee personally appeared before me and ac-  
knowledged this agreement to be their act and  
agreed and requested the same to be recorded, In  
testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
this 14<sup>th</sup> day of October 1805.

This Indenture made this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and five between Martha Watton of the County of Prince Edward in the state of Virginia of the one part & John Wilson of the County of Hardin of the State of Kentucky of the other part witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of five shillings to her in hand paid the receipt of which is fully acknowledged, have granted bargained & sold & by these presents do grant bargain & sell unto the said John Wilson his heirs or assigns one certain tract of land containing by survey sixty acres laying on Green River south on the North side thereof a part of a survey of 1818 acres made ~~in~~ for George Watton & in Hardin County and bounded as follows (County) Beginning at a Hickory white oak and Spanish oak on the north bank of Green River and corner to Vaughn's Survey now Mumford's thence with Vaughn's line North  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile  $45^{\circ}$  degrees west two hundred and twenty eight poles to a large black oak on the west side of a Knob corner to said survey then  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile
