

Infant Orphans of Thomas Redman deceased a judgment which he obtained in Nelson County against Jacob Ryan as administrator of all and singular the goods and chattels credits and rights of Thos Redman deceased also all accounts dues and demands what ever which remains in his hands a possession a which he has right to recover and also to keep the said Richard Lee as Guardian of the said infant orphans of Thos Redman dec'd free and clear from all demands suits damages costs or charges whatever of damages John Dye infant orphan of Anne Redman deceased which he the said John Dye has a may have against the said Richard Lee for the estate or my part of the estate which he the said Richard has received or may here after receive and belonging to the said John Dye as heir of Anne Redman deceased —

and the said Richard Lee doth for himself part obligate himself to keep the said William Redman as administrator of the said Thomas Redman deceased free and clear from all the infant orphans of the said Thomas Redman deceased that they shall not call on the said William Redman for any part of their Father's estate which the said William administered on. and the said Richard doth further agree to and with the said William that he will forever keep him free and clear from all actions suits damages costs and charges whatever which the said William Redman as Guardian administrator of the Thomas Redman deceased. and the said Richard Lee doth hereby (as Guardian of the said orphans) acknowledge that the said William Redman hath delivered unto the said Richard the said estate of Thos Redman dec'd except the within mentioned Judgment and some accounts which he set to deliver

This Indenture made this 22nd day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and five between Martha Watton of the County of Prince Edward in the State of Virginia of the one part & John Wilson of the County of Hardin & State of Kentucky of the other part Witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the sum of five shillings to her in hand paid the Receipt of which is fully acknowledged, have granted bargained & sold & by these presents do grant bargain & sell unto the said John Wilson his heirs or assigns one certain tract of free land containing by Survey sixty acres lying on Green River south on the North side thereof a part of a survey of 1818 acres made in the name of George Watton & in Hardin County and bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at a Hickory white oak and Spanish oak on the north bank of Green River and corner to Vaughn's Survey now Mumfords thence with Vaughn's line North 44 degrees west two hundred and twenty eight poles to a large black oak on the west side of a Knob corner to said survey thence north
